

TECHNICAL COMMITTEES' PROPOSAL

OBJECTIVES FOR ALL COMMITTEES

1. Annual Regional (Sub-Saharan and Northern African) Championships for Pony, Youth and Senior Athletes
2. Review and recommend rules for Championships.
3. Identify areas that require attention and develop Task Forces with objectives and timelines to allow the primary aim – Continental Championships.
i.e., movement of horses
4. Must meet in person once a year where the minority Region must be present. There is no funding from ACES for this travel until funds per discipline are obtained from institutions other than the FEI. The committee should have a minimum of two additional meeting by Skype/ Internet during the calendar year.
5. Minutes of all meetings must be submitted to ACES board within 1 (one) calendar month of the meeting.

MEMBERS OR THE FOLLOWING COMMITTEES SHOULD BE NOMINATED:

JUMPING - Currently 4, 2 should either resign or do a draw to find who will step down.

2 positions open, although both can re-stand

DRESSAGE - Committee of 3 has not been active at all and have had no correspondence from any of them.

EVENTING - Committee of 2. Can elect 2 additional. Committee has not been active.

ENDURANCE – Committee of 3. Slightly active. 1 needs to step down but can stand for re-election.

VAULTING – Committee of 2. Can elect 2 further members.

GUIDELINES FOR THE FORMATION OF ALL SUB-COMMITTEES:

1. Member = Specifically Elected Committee member (and not Country NF Member)
2. Term of office 4 years – renewable once. From the initial Committee, as a transitory provision, at the end of their second year, 2 members of the committee will retire (draw by lot) but be eligible for re-election for a second term.

3. No member nation can be represented by more than 2 members on all committees at one time.
4. Each committee will consist of a maximum of 5 elected members. They will elect their own Chair.
5. Strive for equal split between representation from Northern and Sub-Saharan Africa, but at no time may either region be without representation of at least 20 percent. i.e., 2 out of the 5 elected members.
6. The composition of each Committee should consist of the following groups:
 - a. An athlete competing at FEI 1* Level or above
 - b. A Course Designer/ Technical Delegate / Other FEI official
 - c. An Event Organiser or Public Relations Officer
 - d. An FEI Veterinary Official
 - e. Another Stakeholder directly involved in the discipline.
7. All should be computer literate and able to use SKYPE / What's APP and other communication tools due to the distances and difficulties in communication.
8. Countries nominating members should ideally hold a minimum of two International Competitions of the sub-committee discipline.
 - a. International Competitions should be of a reasonable level. CSI (for Jumping) CEI (for Endurance) CIC (for Eventing). CDI and CVI are only held in one country and so International competition should be the criteria to nominate a representative.
 - b. The World Jumping Challenge, the World Dressage Challenge, The Children's FEI Classic
9. All Nominations must be Vetted by the Representatives on the Nominations Committee (1 from Group IX and 1 from Group VII) prior to release for voting and must receive a letter of no objection by their NF Secretariat.) Subsequent to this, the nominations will be approved by the ACES Board prior to the vote at the General Assembly.
10. Each nomination must be accompanied by a 1-page CV which will be Vetted.
11. Closing date for Nominations – tbc
